

# **In British, students are not recommended to use essay writing services online**

The manager of the examination department of Ofqual, a quality-management education institution in England, criticized students' use of online essay writing services. Students resort to using such services when doing homework, but do not write work on their own.

Many of the essays students buy online contain misspelled words, factual errors, or serious grammatical errors, according to Ofqual. For example, in one of the history essays that the Writing Service offers for sale, there are so many errors that instead of the highest grade A, the student received a very low grade E.

An independent study was conducted, during which it was found out that most likely the work was written by someone who does not live in England and not in Wales, because American phrases and spelling were often used.

Sometimes differences consisted of one letter in a word, such as realized (American version) and realised (British version). Some sentences included words that deprived the sentence of meaning or distorted it. For example, "It is very important that everyone is busy with business, then no one will" terrorize "the rest in society." Obviously, there must be another word in place of "terrorize."

In addition, in many written works, the phrase "residents of the United Kingdom" was often found, which, according to researchers, is a phrase that English students would hardly use, but rather replace with "citizens."

A history essay offered by another company, UK Essays, was rated by experts on C D ratings, which is pretty bad anyway.

Some phrases in them were copied from assignments in textbooks, and some were quite complex, obviously not at school level. There were also minor grammatical and stylistic mistakes.

The essays sold by Custom Essays turned out to be quite high-quality, for which researchers were ready to give a grade of B, although they still sharply condemned their use by students. There were many typos in these works and some sentences were poorly composed. For example, the name Lloyd was spelled Llyod.

But this concerns history, but in English the same company offered essays of the lowest quality for evaluations of E (unit) or U (unsatisfactory). The works were simply of disgusting quality, sometimes completely illiterate.
